Ltd (hereinafter "DRAXTON"), we acknowledge the value of your privacy, as well as your right to informative self-determination. The purpose of this Privacy Notice is to inform you the way in which your personal data is obtained, used, disclosed, stored or, in general, processed, which You voluntarily provide through the website www.draxton.com (hereinafter, the "Web").

Responsible for the Processing

In accordance with the current regulation, the user is informed that the personal data collected through the Web, shall become part of a file whose responsible is Draxton México, S. de R.L. de C.V., company located at Av. Promoción No. 145, Zona Industrial San Luis Potosí, San Luis Potosí, Mexico, unless indicated otherwise in the Web.

If the user contacts any of the member entities of DRAXTON through the contact information provided in the Web (e-mail, postal address, telephone), the user agrees to the processing of his personal data by the subsidiary to which he has addressed, in which case, the latter shall be responsible for processing his personal data in accordance with the applicable regulation of the country in which it is located. The information of the subsidiary companies are duly detailed on the Web. Users shall take this into account when exercising their rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition when addressed directly to a group company through these means.

Personal Data Collected

You can browse the Web without providing personal data, however, there are certain sections within the Web where You can voluntarily provide data such as: name, address, email, telephone and other identifying information. For example, when you communicate with us to request information about our group companies, request information about our products, when you register as a supplier, to send us your comments or suggestions, or when you wish to be considered for a position in one of our companies.

Certain features and accesses on the Web are reserved for registered users only, for example, the "Suppliers' Portal". There are usernames and passwords for registered users of this portal, which are assigned by our Information Technology department. How Do We Use Your Personal Data?

On the other hand, if You are a supplier or you wish to be one, there are specific conditions for the processing of your personal data, which shall be informed to you before collecting your personal data, through the corresponding Privacy Notice.

The personal data you provide shall be kept for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes described herein.

Security Measures/Limits to Access

DRAXTON has adopted the necessary technical, administrative and physical security measures to ensure the integrity and confidentiality of your personal data and to prevent its damage, loss, alteration, destruction or unauthorized use, access or processing, however, it is clear that no data transmission over the Internet is completely secure and, therefore, DRAXTON cannot guarantee that the processing of personal data will be free from any damage, loss, alteration, destruction or unauthorized use, access or processing.

Only authorized personnel, who have fulfilled and observed the corresponding confidentiality requirements, may participate in the processing of your personal data.

How Do We Share Personal Data?

DRAXTON does not sell, assign or transfer personal data to third parties that are not related to DRAXTON, without the previous consent of the data subject.

THE COMPANY will transfer your personal data to competent governmental authorities, either national or foreign, to comply with any legal requirement or provision and with the purposes described in this Privacy Notice.

Other than the cases provided for in this Privacy Notice, THE COMPANY shall not share or transfer your personal data to third parties, except in the cases provided for in Article 37 of the Federal Law for the Protection of Personal Data in Possession of Private Parties or any other applicable legislation or regulation.

Third Party Data

In the event that the user provides personal data of third parties, the user guarantees to have obtained their prior consent and to have previously informed them of the conditions and purposes for which DRAXTON shall use their personal data. If DRAXTON requires it, the user shall evidence to have obtained said consent.

Quality of the Data

The data provided by the user shall be accurate and truthful. In every case, it is the user's obligation to notify DRAXTON of any modification of his data in order to keep them updated at all times.

Your Rights Regarding Your Personal Data

As owner of personal data, you may exercise your rights of access, rectification, cancellation or opposition, known as ARSO-POL rights, before the Personal Data Protection Committee, personally at Boulevard Isidro López Zertuche number 1495, Zona Centro, postal code 25000, Saltillo Coahuila, Mexico or by contacting us via e-mail at datospersonales@gis.com.mx. The ARSO-POL rights are inherent to each person and, therefore, cannot be waived. Below, we describe them and explain what each one of them consists of:

- (i) Right of access. You can know the information regarding the processing that DRAXTON makes of your personal data, but not of other people.
- (ii) Right of rectification. You can correct or modify your data if they are inaccurate or incomplete to ensure that the information we have about you is correct.
 - (iii) Right of cancellation. This allows you to ask us to delete your data.
- (iv) Right of opposition. You may ask us not to process your data or to stop processing it when your consent has not been required for its processing or when you wish us to stop sending you commercial communications.
- (v) Right of Portability. Allows the owner of personal data to transfer his/her personal data from one data controller to another, provided that some characteristics are met.
- (vi) Right of Limitation. Allows the data subject to obtain from the data controller a limitation to the data processing, when the conditions established in the applicable regulations are met.
 - (vii) Opposition to the processing with automated decisions. Allows guaranteeing





to the data subject that he or she shall not be subject to decisions based solely in the processing of his/her data with automated decisions, including the creation of profiles, which produces legal effects on him/her or significantly affects him/her.

Likewise, you may revoke at any time, the consent you have granted and that is necessary for the processing of your personal data, as well as limit the use or disclosure of your personal data. DRAXTON shall make available, on the Web, the suggested formats for the exercise of ARCO rights.

Changes to the Privacy Notice
